



Figure 3: The New Zealand and South Seas Exhibition Orchestra with conductor Arthur Towsey standing at the centre of the photograph. The orchestra leader, Raffaello Squarise, is seated in front of him. Burton Brothers (photographers), Hocken Collections, E 1816/1.

#### The Data Exchange Agreement

The Europeana Licensing Framework is enabling the Europeana Strategic plan 2011-2015. It's center piece is the Data Exchange Agreement (DEA), a contract which is signed by each Europeana partner and which governs the re-use conditions of metadata and previews but leaves partners free to implement whichever regime they see fir for their digitised objects. Working with the Europeana stakeholders is a key activity and reflected by extensive consultation, including community norm-setting through the Europeana Metadata guidelines.

- The Europeana Foundation has now officially adopted The Europeana Data Exchange Agreement. The official version replaces the previous Data Provider and Data Aggregator Agreement.
- The Agreement is the result of a year-long consultation process with the network of content providers and aggregators. Stakeholder Workshops on Data Exchange Agreement took place http://www.version1.europeana.eu/web/europeana-project/newagreement-consultation/
- We have also written Usage Guidelines for metadata. These are non-binding, but they set out the responsibilities that people who want to reuse the data should be aware of
- Data Exchange Transition Schedule
- License Selection Tool License Selection Tool v1.1.

The Europeana Public Domain Charter is second key deliverable, which required extensive consultation, giving guidance for valuing and dealing with expired rights. A Public Domain Mark was launched together with Creative Commons.



Haere Mai and welcome to the New Zealand Asia Information Service (NZAIS), a freely available resource for researchers focusing on business information and engagement between New Zealand and Asia.

NZAIS is a joint project between NZAI and The University of Auckland Library. It has four main features:

- 1. A searchable database of articles and other materials about New Zealand's business engagement with Asia
- 2. Links to other databases offering complementary information about Asia, in several languages
- 3. RSS feeds featuring news about NZ business engagement with Asia, with auto-translators
- 4. A directory of Asian expertise and researchers at The University of Auckland

NZAIS website is intended for use by academic staff and students, organisations involved with business, trading, social and cultural exchange with Asia or other researchers for the purposes of reference, research and analysis.

The research database links key information sources to New Zealand's past and present engagement with Asian countries into one resource that researchers and analysts can use as an organised access point to begin their research.




