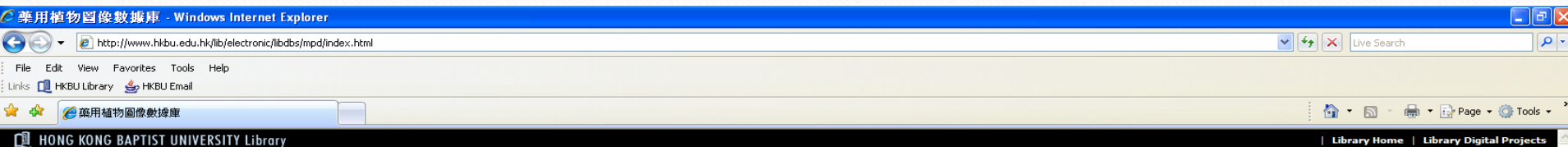

# Example: Medicinal Plant Image Database (MPID)

- first Hong Kong-developed online Medicinal Plant Image Database
- launched in November 2009
- free public access to the world
- collaborative effort between School of Chinese Medicine and the University Libraries
- aiming to promote popularization, internationalization and resources sharing of traditional medicinal plants
- Currently 1160 species of medicinal plant were systematically consolidated and summarized in the form of plant images and annotations.
- provides students with perceptual and systematic knowledge through user friendly searching and learning tools

# Medicinal Plant Image Database (MPID)



## 中醫藥學院 School of Chinese Medicine 藥用植物圖像數據庫

藥用植物作為中醫文化的主要物質基礎，其歷史源遠流長，種類繁多。為了推進藥用植物研究的普及化、國際化和信息共享，建立藥用植物數據庫顯得尤為重要。本數據庫建立在對藥用植物的長期調查研究和經驗、信息積累的基礎上，以植物圖片附加文字說明的形式，對上千種藥用植物進行系統的整理、歸類、總結。本數據庫的建立以輔助教學為主要目的，旨在通過此數據庫使學生對藥用植物形成直觀、系統的認知，並提供便捷的檢索、學習途徑。本數據庫的建立是香港浸會大學中醫藥學院和圖書館共同合作的結晶。

Medicinal plants, as an important material basis of Chinese medicine culture, have a long standing history and variety. Establishing this online database is critical for promoting its popularization, internationalization and resource sharing. Based on long-term accumulated studies, experience and information on medicinal plants, the project team systematically consolidates and summarizes thousands of medicinal plants in the form of images and annotations. With the aim of supporting teaching and learning, the database will provide students with perceptual and systematic knowledge through a user friendly searching and learning tool. The online database is a collaborative project between the School of Chinese Medicine and the Library, HKBU.

 【拉丁學名】*Panax ginseng* C.A. Mey.  
 【科屬歸類】五加科 Araliaceae, 人參屬 *Panax*  
 【植物形態】多年生草本，高約30-70厘米。肉質主根肥大，有淡黃色外皮，呈紡錘形或圓柱形，末端多分枝。直立根莖短，每年增生一節，通稱蘆頭，或有一至數條不定根，習稱芋。單一莖直立，光滑無毛。掌狀複葉輪生莖端，一年生者生三出複葉一片，二年生者生五出複葉一片，三年生者生五出複葉兩片，以後每年遞增一片複葉，最多可達6片複葉；卵形或長橢圓形至橢圓形或披針形小葉片多為5枚，偶為3或7枚，中間3片幾等大，長4.5-15厘米，闊2.2-4厘米，基部的一對較小，長2-4厘米，寬1-1.5厘米；小葉柄長1-3厘米；小葉先端漸尖，基部楔形，有細鋸齒於邊緣，上面沿葉脈有稀疏剛毛，下面無毛。傘形花序單一頂生，總花梗長達7-25厘米，每花序有10-80朵花，集結成圓球形；花小，直徑2-3毫米；綠色齒狀花萼5；淡黃色卵形花瓣5，先端鈍；雄蕊5，花絲短，長圓形花藥；子房下位，花柱上部2裂，杯狀花盤。扁球形核果漿果狀，直徑5-9毫米，成熟時為鮮紅色。乳白色種子2粒，呈半圓形。花期5-7月，果期7-9月。  
 【生境分佈】生於海拔數百米的針葉闊葉混交林或雜木林下，有栽種。分佈吉林、遼寧、黑龍江、河北、山西、陝西、內蒙古等地。藥材主產吉林、遼寧、黑龍江等地。  
 【藥用部位】以根、葉入藥。中藥名：根：人參。葉：人參葉。  
 【採收加工】根：一般栽種6年左右採收，9-10月採挖。洗淨，除去莖葉後加工成生曬參、紅參、糖參等。野山參採挖時防止折斷支根及鬚根。但多數都加工成生曬參。葉：秋季採收，晾乾或烘乾。  
 【主要成份】主要含有皂苷類成分(如人參皂苷Rb1、Rg1、Rg2)或多糖類成分。  
 【藥理作用】調節中樞神經系統，改善記憶能力，提升免疫功能，強心，抗缺血，擴張血管，降壓，適應原樣作用，抗腫瘤。  
 【性味功能】根：甘，微苦，微溫。葉：苦、甘，寒。根：大補元氣，補脾益肺，生津，安神益智。葉：補氣益肺，祛暑生津。  
 【主治用法】根：用於體虛欲脫，肢冷脈微，脾虛食少，肺虛喘咳，津傷口渴，內熱消渴，久病虛羸，驚悸失眠，陽痿宮冷；心力衰竭，心原性休克。葉：用於氣虛咳嗽，暑熱煩躁，津傷口渴，頭目不清，四肢倦怠。根：內服：煎湯，3-10克(大劑量30克)，宜另煎兌入；研末，1-3克；或熬膏、泡酒、入丸、散。實熱證、濕熱證及正氣不虛者禁服。不宜與藜蘆同用。葉：內服：煎湯，6-10克。不宜與藜蘆同用。脾胃虛寒者慎服。  
 【應用舉例】根：真陽不足，上氣喘急，自汗盜汗，氣虛頭暈：人參15克，炮附子30克。水煎服，加生姜十片。(濟生續方)  
 葉：發熱不退，微惡風寒，口渴多飲，汗少小便多：銀花12克，薄荷12克，人參葉12克，白糖30克。水煎服。(季節性疾病的食療)

 【Chinese Pinyin】 Lianjiadou  
 【English Name】 Alyce Clover, Divergent Alyce Clover, Sheath Chainpodpea  
 【Latin Name】 *Allyscarpus vaginalis* (L.) DC.  
 【Family & Genus】 豆科 Fabaceae，鏈莢豆屬 *Alyscarpus*  
 【Description】

Perennial herb. Horizontal or upper stems erect, 30-90 cm high. Leaves only a single leaf, alternate, stems, usually the Ministry of lobules linear-lanceolate, oblong-lanceolate or ovate-oblong, 3-6.5 cm, the lower leaf is heart-shaped, nearly round or oval, long a -3 cm, glabrous above, slightly pubescent below, lateral veins 4-5 pairs; petiole 0.5-1.4 cm long, glabrous; stipules linear-lanceolate, with petioles nearly as long. Racemes axillary or apical, 1.5-7 cm long, with flowers of 6-12, arranged in pairs in the Festival; bracts membranaceous, ovate-lanceolate, with the calyx of equal length; pedicel 3-4 mm long; calyx 5-6 mm long, compared with the first pod section slightly longer; corolla violet-blue, slightly out of calyx, petals obovate flag; stamens 10; ovary sparsely pubescent, ovules 4-7. Pod density, flat cylindrical, 1.5-2.5 cm long, pubescent; pod section 4-7, section between the non-shrink, pubescent, a network of wrinkles, the boundary between the lines are slightly elevated ring. Flowering in September.

【Distribution】 Born in open grassland, dry side, street or beach sand. Distributed in Taiwan, Fujian, Guangdong, Hainan, Guangxi and Yunnan provinces.

【Part Used】 To the whole plant medicine. Chinese name: dog ants grass.

【Harvest & Processing】 Summer and autumn harvest, wash, fresh or dried.

【Properties & Actions】 Sweet, bitter, cool. Huoxuetongluo, bone swelling, heat and detoxification.

【Indications & Usage】 For bone fracture, myalgia, traumatic bleeding, sore ulcers eventually becoming shut, numps, chronic hepatitis. Oral: Jiantang 30-60 grams. External: amount, leaf trace deposited; or fresh whole plant Jianshui Washing; sprinkle powdered leaves. 1. bruises, fractures: (dog ants grass) fresh whole plant pounded for external application. (National Chinese herbal medicine)  
2. Traumatic bleeding: (dog ants grass) leaf mash and apply; or sprinkle with powdered leaves the affected area. (National Chinese herbal medicine)  
3. Ulcerated sore shut up long-suppressed: (dog ants grass) Washing fresh whole plant decoction, and sprinkle with powdered leaves the affected area. (National Chinese herbal medicine)

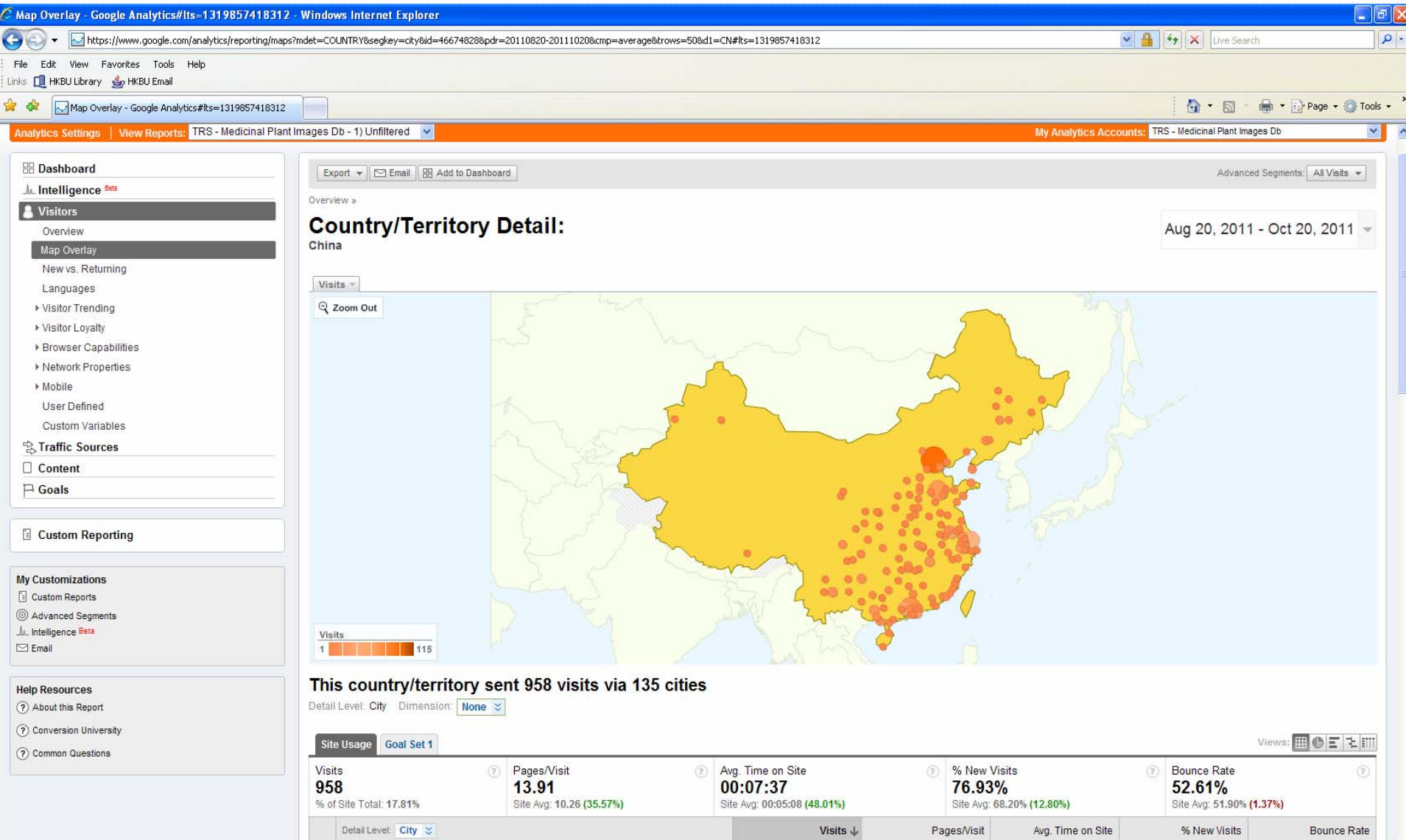

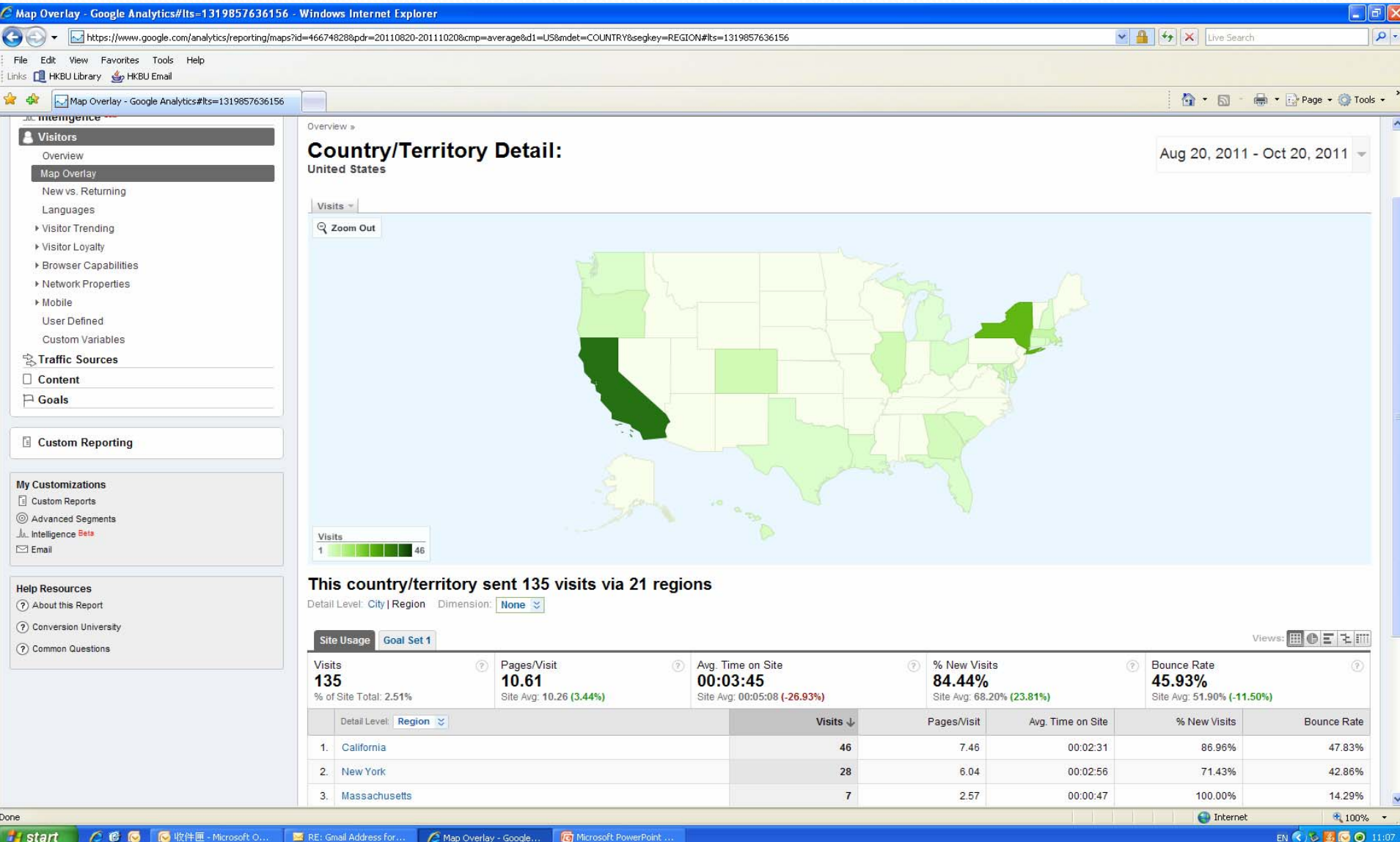

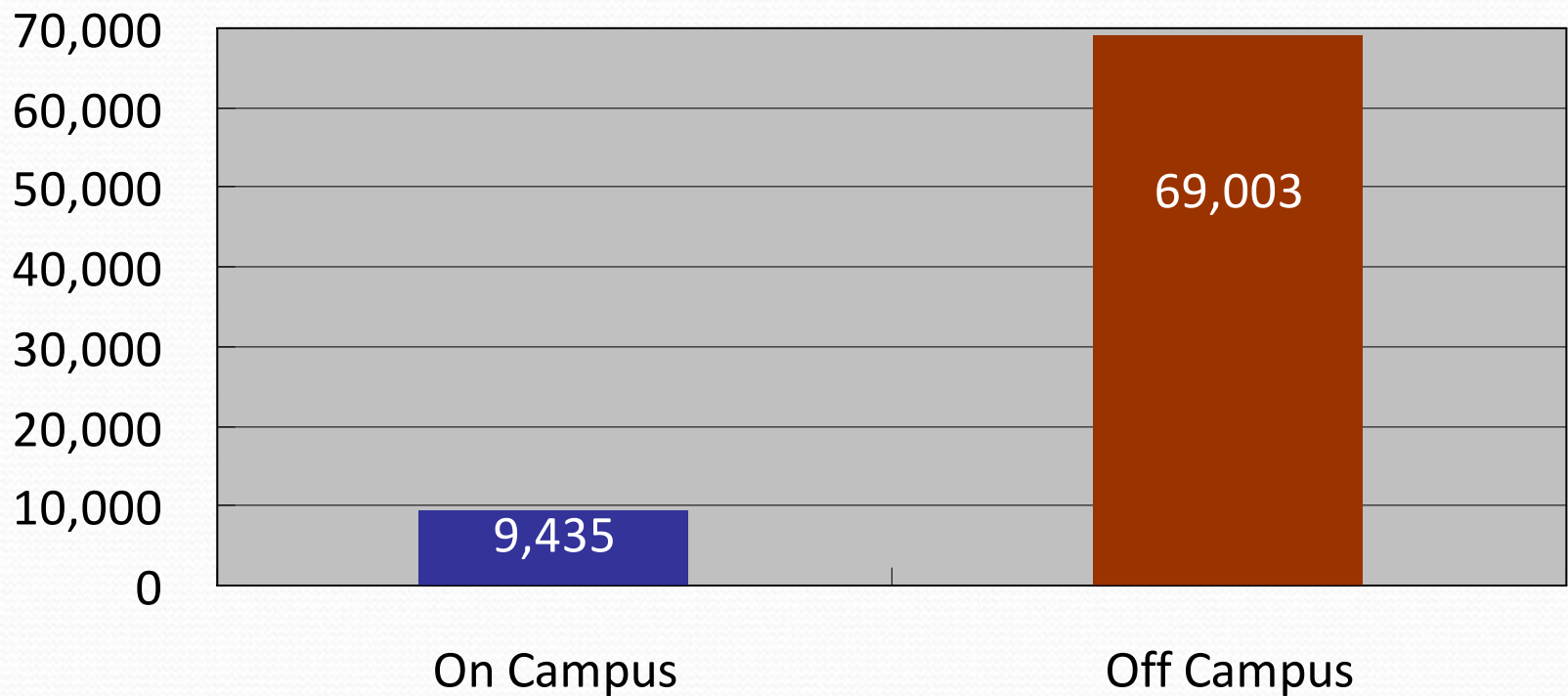

## Total Usage (No. of Video Views) since July 2010



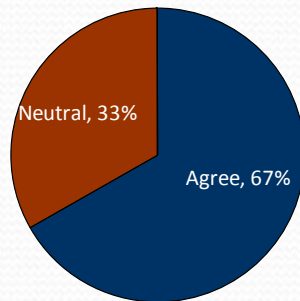

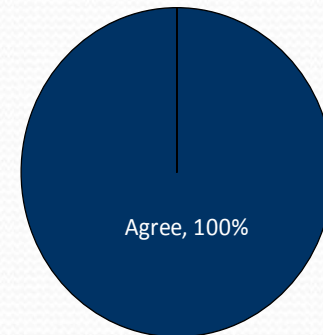
- Faculty survey

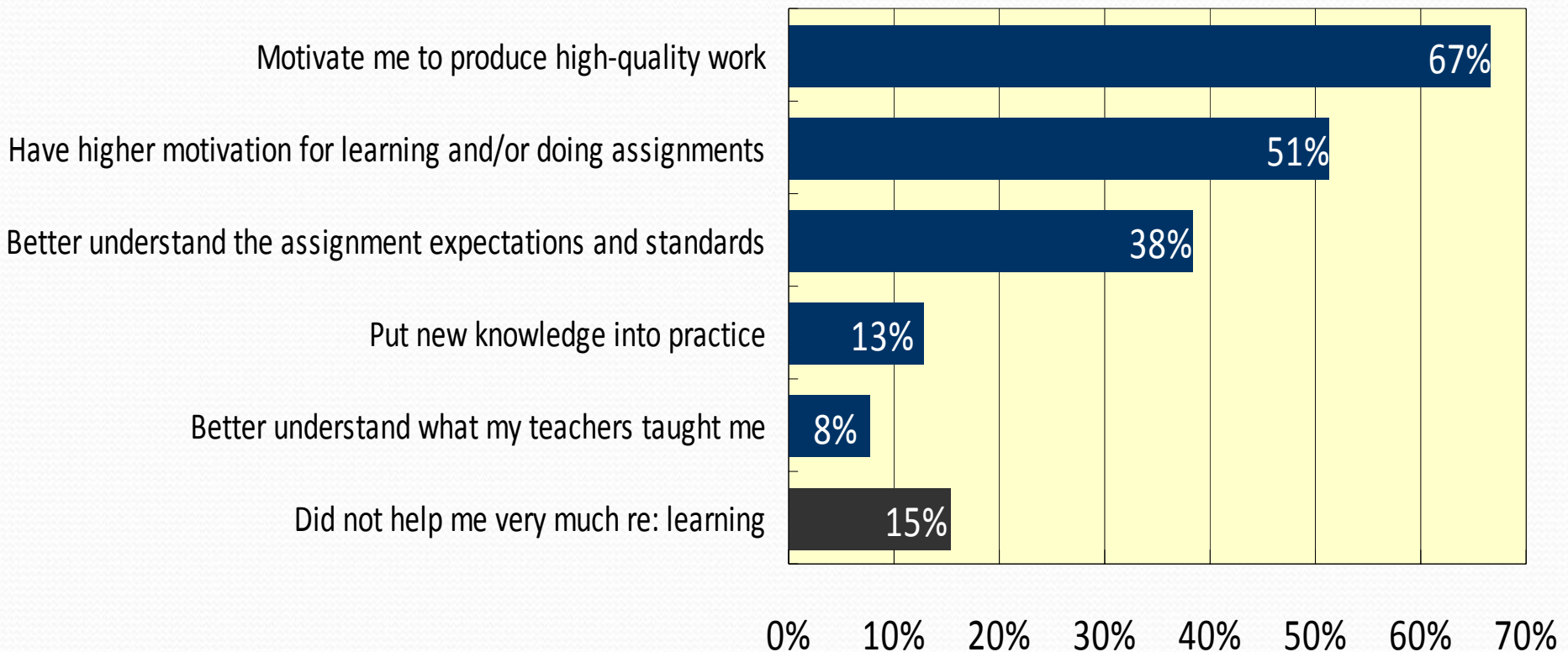

# Student Survey (AF) 21.3% response rate

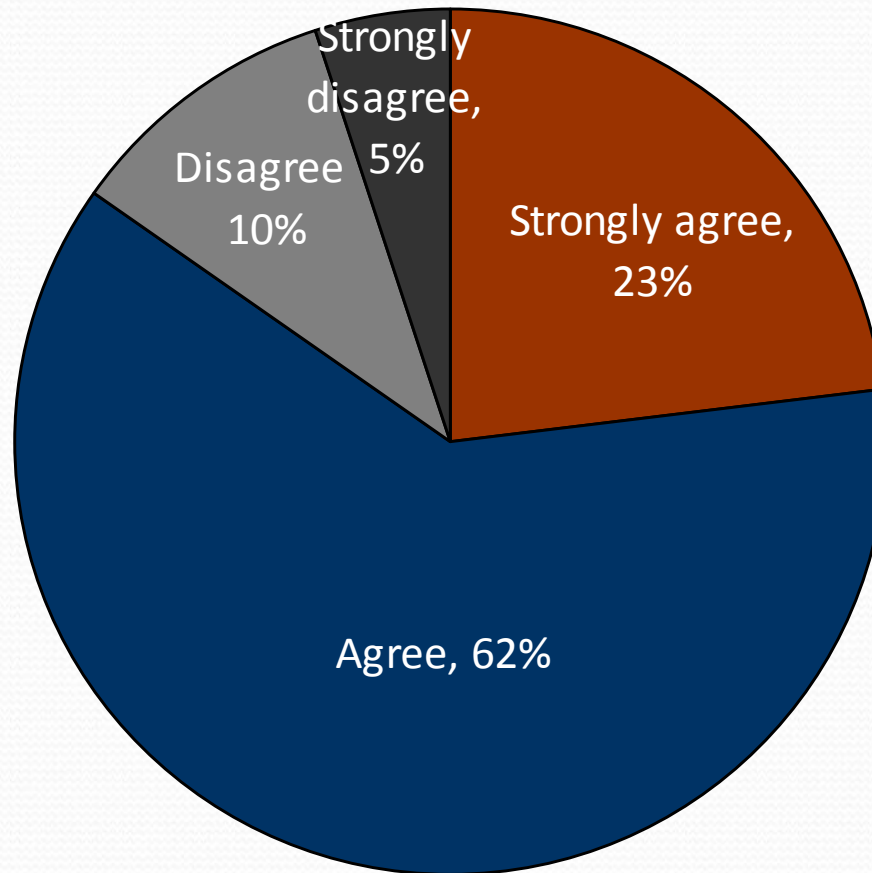
- Student Perceived Usage of HKBUtube (SP)

# Missionaries in China

- Database projects on Missionaries in China are taken on by the Special Collections and Archives (SCA) where these materials are housed;
- SCA at HKBU Libraries
  - Missions:
    - To serve as a research center in Asia for researchers and scholars in the research of Christianity in China.
    - Regardless of denomination or nationality, the collection covers both primary and secondary English and Chinese language source materials about Chinese Christians, missionaries stationed in China, church history, and other materials pertaining to the history of Christianity in China.



# Missionaries in China

- Four digitization projects:
  - Preservation of Denominational Periodicals in Hong Kong
    - Funded by the “Kenneth Scott Latourette Initiative for the Documentation of World Christianity Fund” of Yale Divinity School Library
    - Started in July 2010 and completed in Feb. 2011
  - China Through the Eyes of CIM Missionaries
    - Created in 2003
    - 225 lantern slides and glass plate negatives documenting the socio-economic activities of the Chinese and missionaries from the 1900s to the 1930s
    - Usage statistics
      - July 2010 – June 2011: 19,500 hits
      - July – September 2011: 5,629 hits



# Missionaries in China

- Christianity in Contemporary China Clippings
  - Created in 2004
  - Collected from 123 Chinese and English newspapers and periodicals published in China, Taiwan, Hong Kong and Southeast Asia
  - Fulltext images of the clippings are only available on Library's intranet because of copyright restriction
  - Usage statistics
    - July 2010 – June 2011: 248,897 hits
    - July – September 2011: 21,9029 hits
- Christianity Rare Books Database
  - Created in 2008,
  - Collaboration project with the University Chaplain's Office
  - Includes images of 36 Chinese stitch-bound rare books on Bible commentary and Christianity published in the late 19th and early 20th centuries

十節 注目，考希利尼本文之字，與九節十一節之見字不同，二人，即天使以成人形者，見約二十四章四節，或曰此恐為摩西與以利亞其人，昔嘗現以事主者，見約九節十一節，如是而來，即指主將成人身而來，亦著於雲中，群天使以事之。

十一節 橄欖山，大抵即為旁橄欖山東之伯大尼村，見約四章五節，安息日所行之程，約不及一英里，猶太人於安息日行程，限之如此，殆在野時，建幕以為殿，距營最遠者，約不及一英里，遂沿其例云，考伯大尼村，距耶路撒冷城，約不及二英里之遙，見約九節十一節。

十二節 樓，即使徒輩日集祈禱言談之所，恐即主嘗選以食臨越節者，觀馬可十四章十五節，路加二十二章十二節，皆記大樓，考希利尼本文，與本節不同，至歷叙使徒之名，可與馬太十章二節註並參之路加記此亦記之最後者。

十四節 壹心，參觀羅馬十五章六節，耶穌母馬利亞，聖經此後已不復及馬利亞之名，此僅記其與門徒同集祈禱，固未嘗謂其掌握何權，或於使徒前，立言勸勵也，與其兄弟句，參觀馬太十三章五十五節，約翰七章二至五節，哥林多前十五章七節等註。

十五節 斯時，即計自主升天，至五旬聖靈降時之間，彼得立於中，使徒有彼得常先言之，亦先行之，無論燕居言議，廣聚往來，皆然，但絕不握權以制同為使徒者，亦不岸然自

十六節 主，有事則廣相與計議也，集者百有二十人，此門徒之居於耶路撒冷者，幾乎盡集，其在加利利者，大抵較此加多，見約林多前十五章六節，人，考希利尼本文譯名，觀默示錄三章四節，撒狄人，十一章十三節，曰七千人，希利尼本文皆譯以名字。

十七節 兄弟，即希利尼人之通稱，表恭敬意，參見二章三十七節，七章三十一節，已應，參觀馬太首章二十二節註。

十八節 購田，或譯獲田，此田實為祭司取猶大所擲之金以購者，但亦可謂猶大買之，然則猶大取買主之價，以獲此田，是以血償血之罰，故稱之曰血田，七章三十一節，本節與下節，大抵非彼得之言，乃作者參其意以補之，身仆，參觀馬太二十七章五節，即指向前一仆，其初解時，始自高而下，不謂其繩忽斷，以致前仆而身裂也，馬太二十七章五節，客記其事，以明其已為上帝所詛也，參見廿三節，本兩節稍加猶大之苦，以及臨死之情形。

十九節 方言，即猶太人自遭虜於巴比倫後之方言也。

二十節 詩云，此伸論上十六節所載之意，基督之職，此兩引詩言，見六十九篇，作詩者，皆記一公義之人，為奸謀遇害，後害之者，亦罹刑戮，是詩之意，固有關於當時之事，但亦為
