

<mark>归纳与小结:数字说话</mark> Summary and findings: Quantities

A rough estimate of the number of items made available through digitization and/or publication among 6 libraries:

- 1. Fudan : 4 projects, 167,033 items
- 2. PKU : 13 projects, 577,400 items
- 3. NTU : 8 projects, 498,789 items
- 4. SYSU : 6 projects, 121,797 items
- 5. Wuhan : 3 project, 72,862 items
- 6. ZJU : 1 project, 2.5 millions (excluded in total)
- Total: 6 libraries, 35 projects, about 1.5 million (1,437,881 items, medium size library?)
- Note: Item=digital objects(image files, full-text of article)

Earliest Projects :

- Peking University Famous Scholars-1998
- Taiwan Old Photoes-2001

Note: "Early digitization projects include the Digital Museum of the Tamsui River, carried out in 1998 and 1999." <u>http://dtrap.lib.ntu.edu.tw/DTRAP/en/index.htm</u> But not included in survey response.

Since 2002, significantly increased the scale:

- Number of projects
- Size of collections (catalog records)
- Number of items or digital objects

Earliest project-PKU Scholars:

Most of the materials are from Peking University Publication and Historic Materials Collection(北大文库). Very valuable first-hand materials such as photos, dairy, hand scripts, drawings, etc.

- Initiated in 1998 as local digitization project:
- Comprehensive data of 235 famous PKU professors, with sizable, multi-formats materials
 - Images: 3000+ pieces,
 master/derivative/browse
 - Full-text articles: 100+
 - Catalog records: 480+
 - Audio/video materials

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Later funded by CALIS 3rd phrase, to develop the "Famous Chinese Scholars Database" cooperated with other 9 project member libraries: 3065 individuals, about 140000 items





Earliest project-Old Photos of Taiwan:

One of the most comprehensive photo collection of its kind with a wide spectrum of areas including society, education, commerce, politics, transportation, industry, people, culture, religion, architecture, landscape, plants, animals, etc

Most of the materials of CADAL project is digital books and periodicals covering all the important disciplines so that CADAL plays a great supporting role for teaching and scientific research."
- CALIS Project:
- "Famous teachers database of Wuhan University was funded by CALIS, cooperated with Wuhan University Archives. The project collected 378 Wuhan University teacher's basic information, books, papers, photographs, video, courseware, research projects, awards, news, social commentary and other information which would help the public to know Wuhan University and teachers in Wuhan University well."

- promoting the digitalization of Minguo (Pre-1949 Republic of China) Publications.
- PRDLA Mainland China members all participated in.
- Local databases & platforms established
 - PKU
 - SYSU
 - Fudan

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CALIS 2nd phrase-RSC Project: Repository of Special Collection in Chinese higher education

- One of the important sub-projects of CALIS during the 10th five-years plan of China
- Approved by CALIS in 2003 with Initial budget ¥1 million, additional investment ¥300,000, total in ¥1,300,000
- 75 sub-projects were granted and divided into three categories
- 63 sub-projects had finished and 58 passed evaluation by Expert Board
- Statistics of 55 sub-projects by the end of May 2006:
 - Metadata records: 4.45 million
 - full-text documents: 1.76 million (about 40% of the whole repository)



CALIS 3rd phrase-RSC Project: Repository of Special Collection in Chinese higher education

- Continued.....with emphasis on:
 - mining and integrating local featured special collection among not only large but also medium and small sizes university libraries in order to
 - promoting in a broad scale the digitization of unique or rare materials and the discovery and harvesting of born-digital materials.
 - Formulating and promoting the standards and guidelines of digitization and digital collection development and
 - Developing centralized metadata repository of special collections
- Approved by CALIS in 2010 with
 - a budget totally ¥2.7 million
 - 220 sub-projects were granted to 189 libraries



CALIS 3rd phrase-RSC Central Portal: <u>http://scs.calis.edu.cn/</u>

Statistics:

- •200 sub-projects finished by May 2012
- •Metadata records: 5.63 million
- •Digital objects: 8.19 million (63% of metadata associated with digital object records: full text, images, etc)
- Centralized CALIS-RSC service portal with links to sub-projects databases
- Develop SaaS based special collection platform
- Finished a series of standards and guidelines



We think "Opening up hidden collections among PRDLA libraries is either <u>very important</u> or <u>important</u>."

- Open Access: 12 PKU(5) NTU(5) SYSU(1), Wuhan (1)
- Partly Open Access: 1 NTU(1) (OA metadata not full-text)
- Campus-Only: 18 PKU(8) SYSU(4) Fudan(3) Wuhan(3)
- Library-only: 1 NTU (1)
- Special permission: 2 NTU(1) ZJU(1, CADAL)
- Not available: **1** Fudan (1)



Strategies, Issues, and Viewpoints:

• Major barriers to opening up hidden special collections include:

We are lacking of everything, especially funding & Staffing.

- PRDLA libraries should coordinate efforts to open up hidden collections by (select all that apply):
 - Forming an oversight committee for coordination and communication.
 - Jointly seeking funding such as government grants and foundation support.
 - Working individually, but keeping each other informed.
 - Working within member libraries' geographic regions (e.g. country). **V**
 - Continuing the discussion at future PRDLA meetings.

We are open to any chances of cooperation but another "committee"



PRDLA libraries should work together to create a shared infrastructure in the form of (rank your choices 1 to 5, with 5 being the most important):

The responses are very diversified. But a slightly stronger preference for repository at home institution with information made available to PRDLA either through a union catalog or an existing infrastructure. While it is clear less preference to have a central repository.

观察与思考 Observation and perspectives

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- Open or not open? A willingness of open but still keep closed......
- Collaboration or stay alone: A willingness of collaboration but lack of actions. more collaboration between various stakeholders and more creative production and business models, not to say industries and libraries, libraries with libraries, consortiums with consortiums, etc.
- Discovery: a COMMON platform for searching, vs. a PRIVATE one
- Grouping: according to specialized collections or subjects
