From PRDLA to PRRLA

In 2015, we voted to change our organization name from Pacific Rim Digital Libraries Alliance to Pacific Rim Research Libraries Alliance



PRRLA-APRU Affiliation

- 21 PRRLA members work in APRU universities; 11
 PRRLA members work in non-APRU universities
- 25 universities were members of APRU and not PRRLA.
- The PRRLA-APRU affiliation was approved in June 2016
- We invited all APRU libraries to join.

New Membership Criteria (proposed)

- Members must be a Pacific Rim research library.
 - APRU member libraries are automatically invited to become PRRLA members due to our joint affiliation; PRRLA members do not have to be APRU members
- Interest and demonstrated involvement in cooperative ventures among academic research libraries located around the Pacific Rim to improve access to scholarly research materials.
- Provide high quality services, collections, and resources that support research, academic excellence, and innovation for their higher education institutions.
- Have a strong global orientation and interest in collaboration and information sharing.
