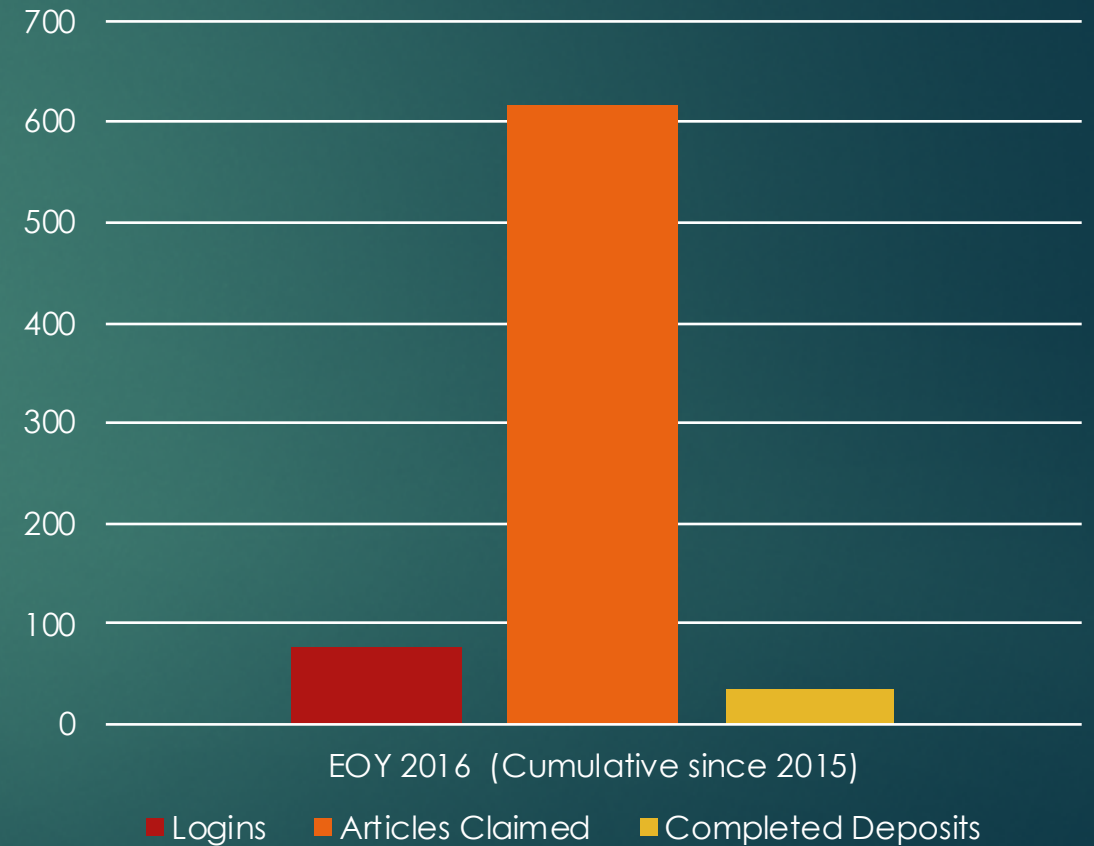
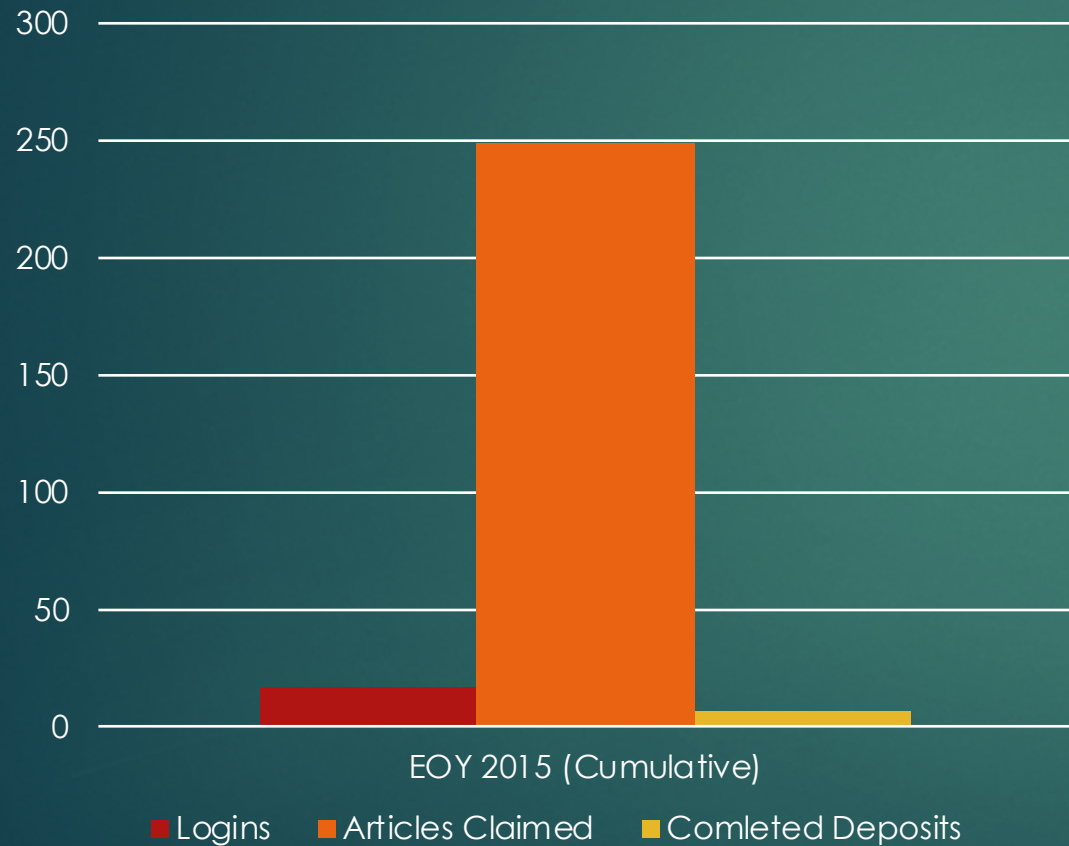
The UC Open Access Policies

- ▶ Senate Open Access Policy
 - ▶ Written and passed by the UC Academic Senate
 - ▶ Covers all UC Senate Faculty
- ▶ Presidential Open Access Policy
 - ▶ Written by a working group charged by the UC Office of the President
 - ▶ Covers all non-Senate UC employees

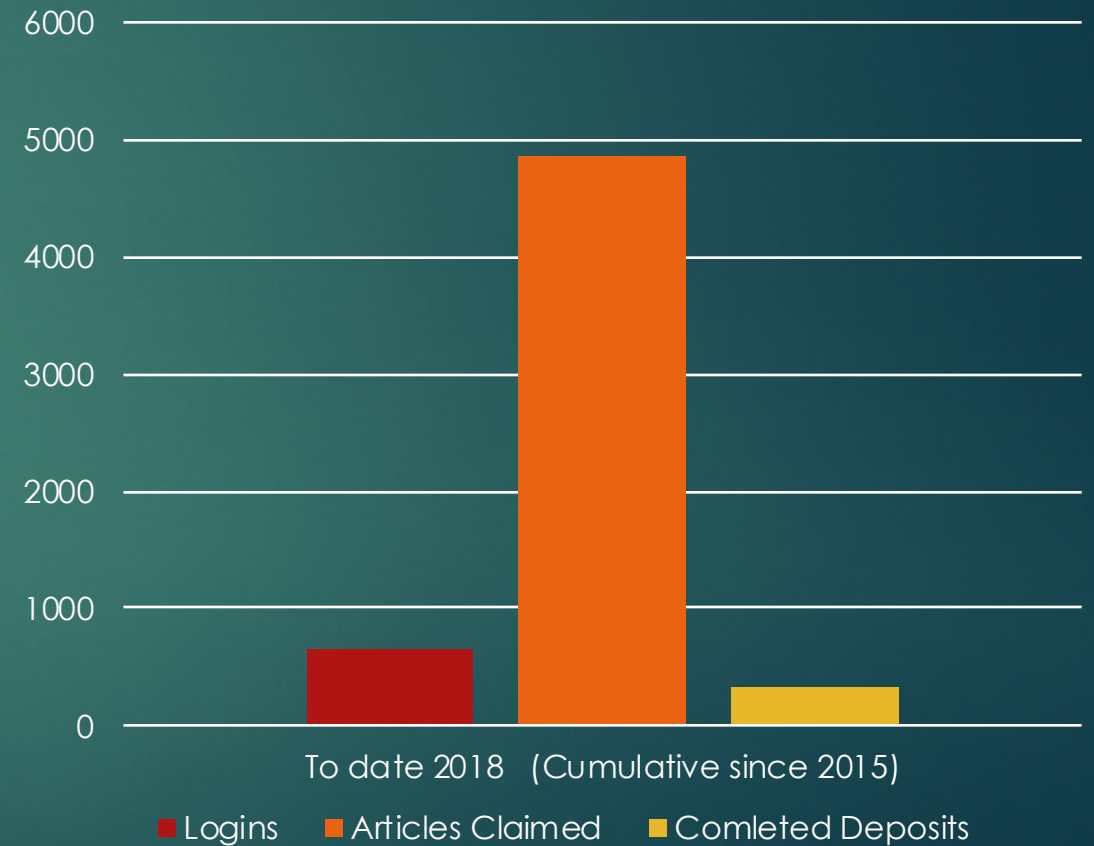
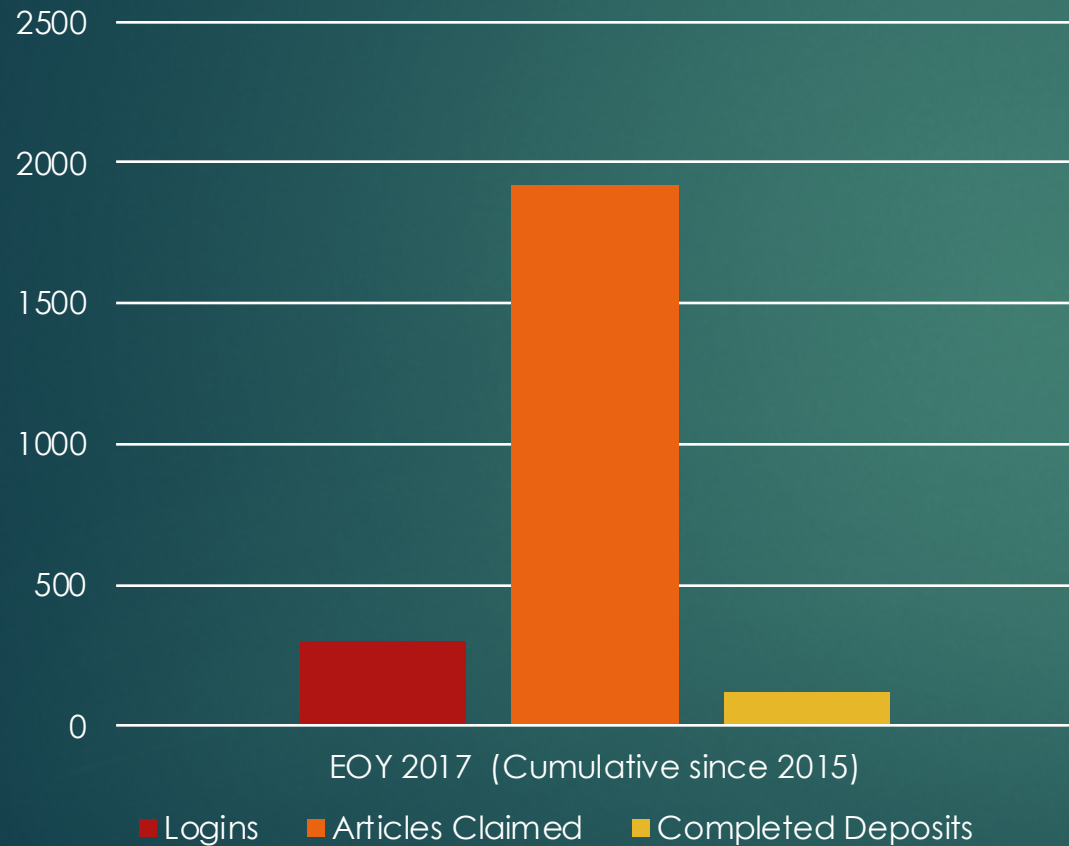
The UC Publication Management System

- ▶ Harvests article citation information from various sources
- ▶ Authors can claim / reject articles harvested into their System profiles
 - ▶ Option to deposit files into eScholarship
 - ▶ Option to provide URL to OA version of article

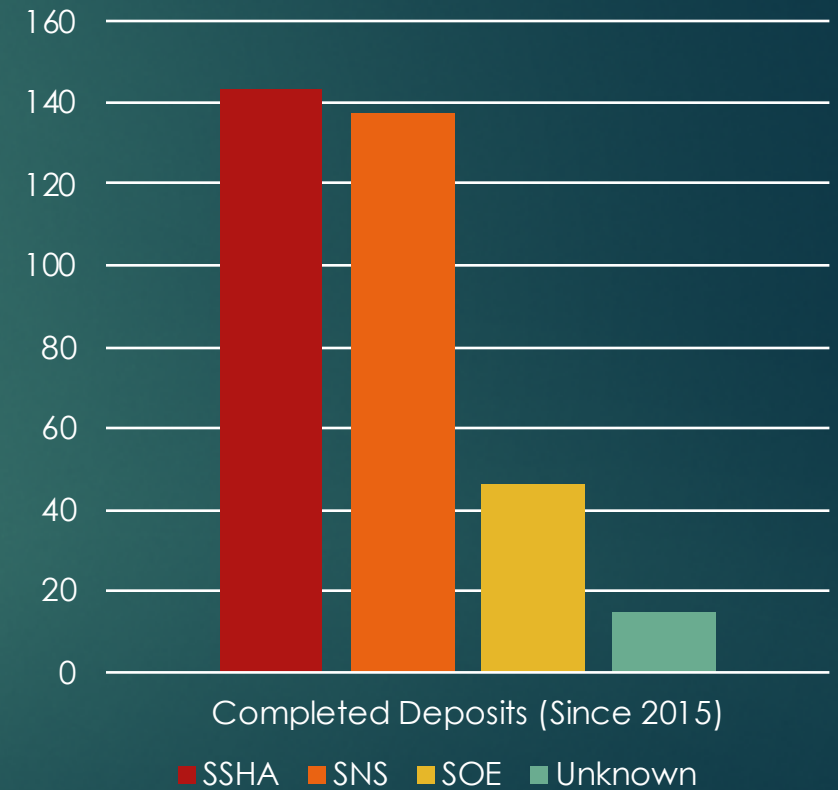
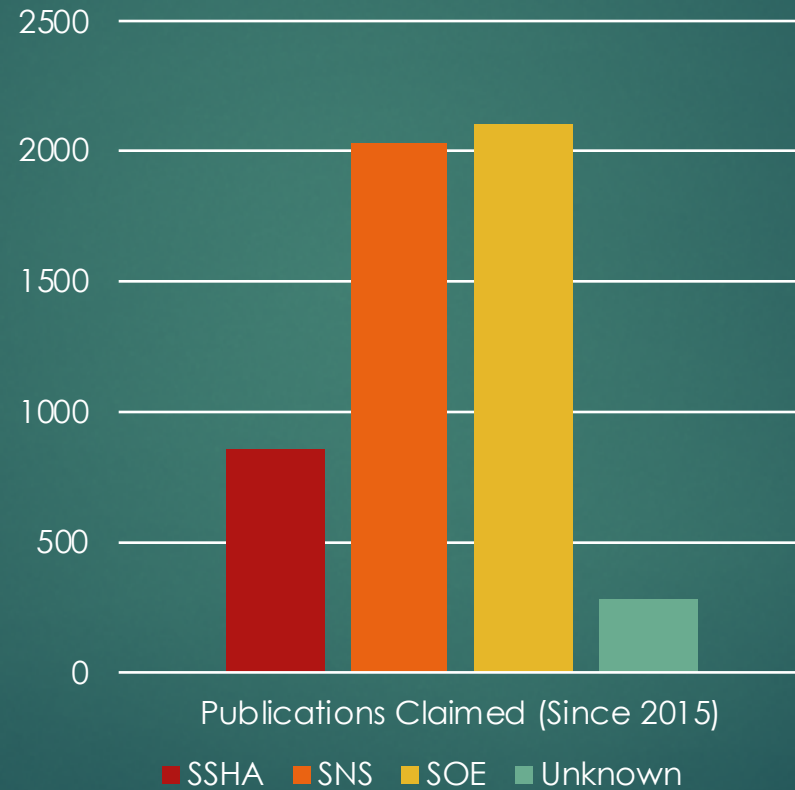
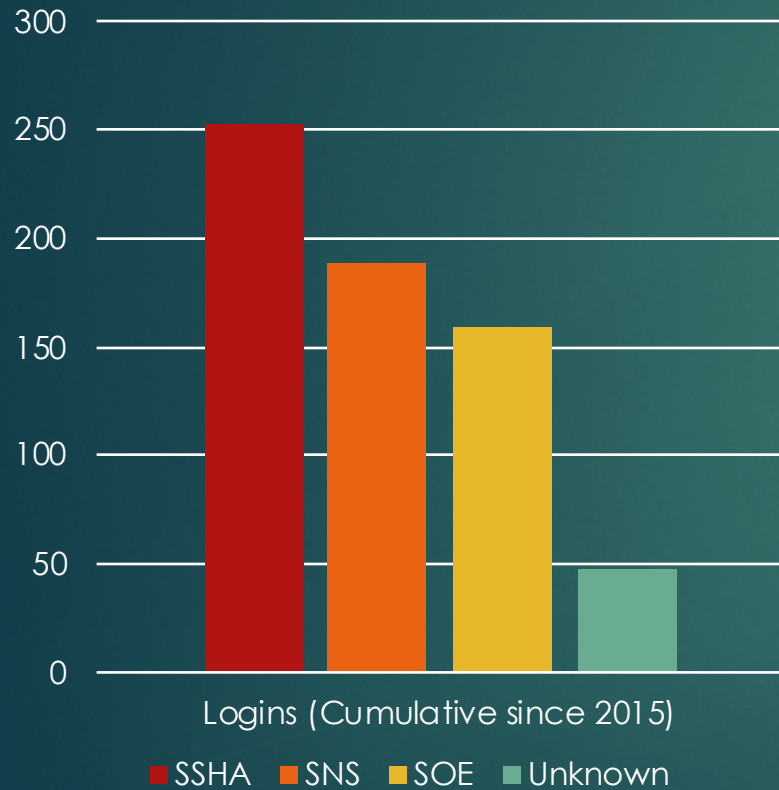

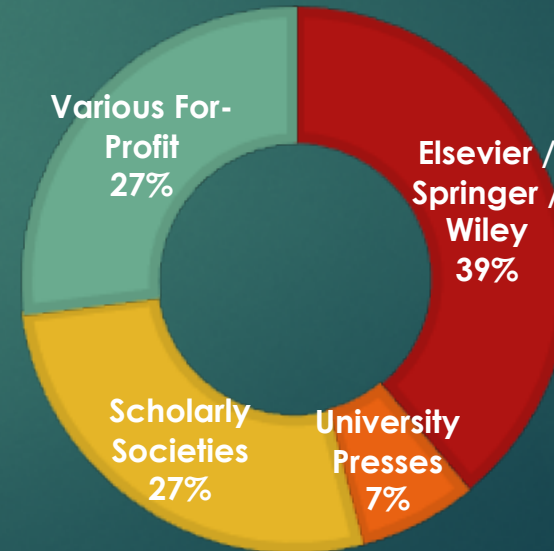

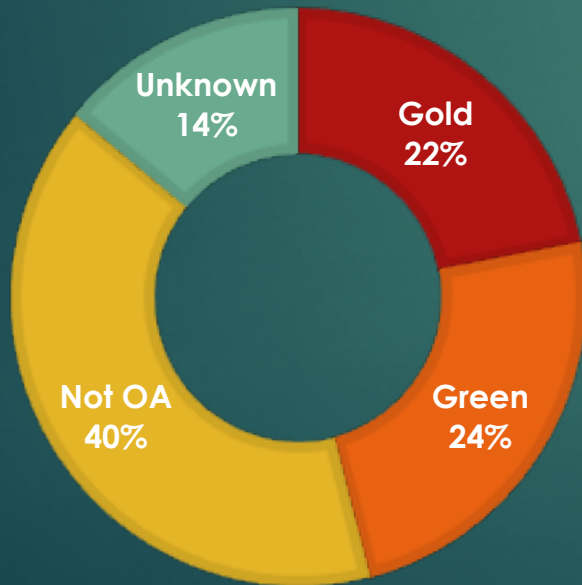

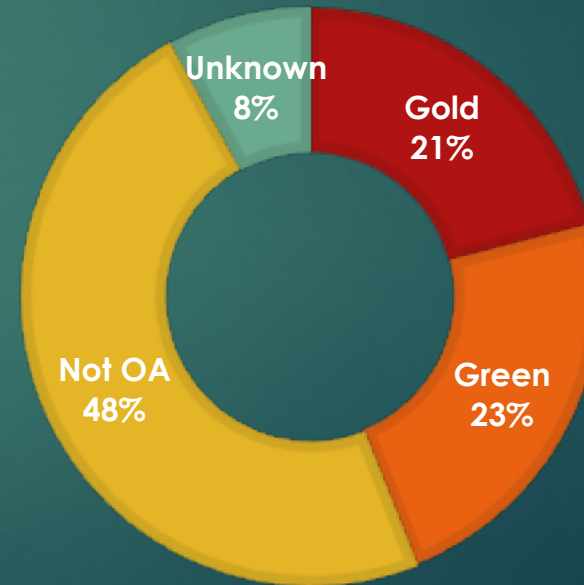

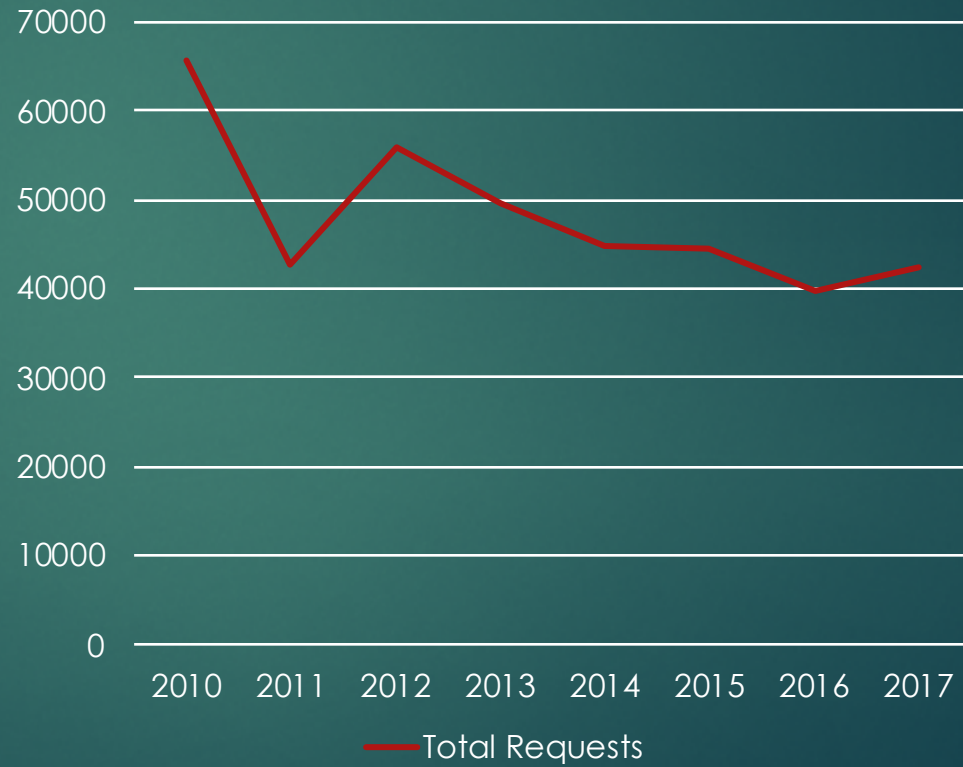
- ▶ Faculty Initiated

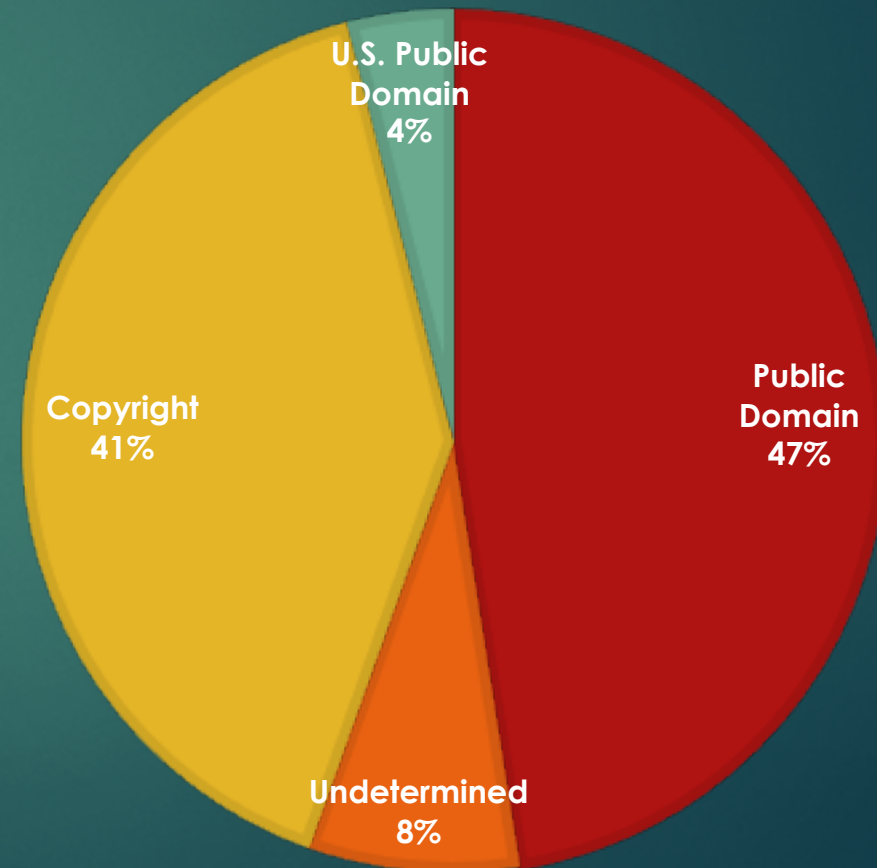

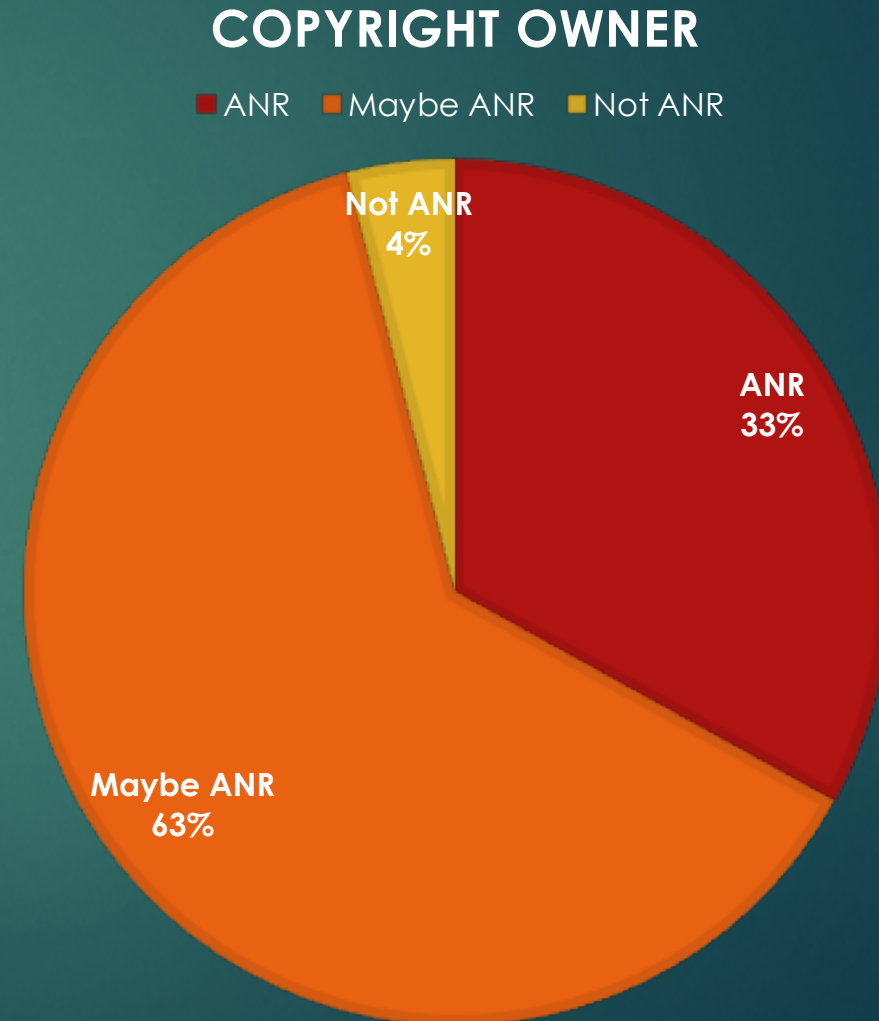
