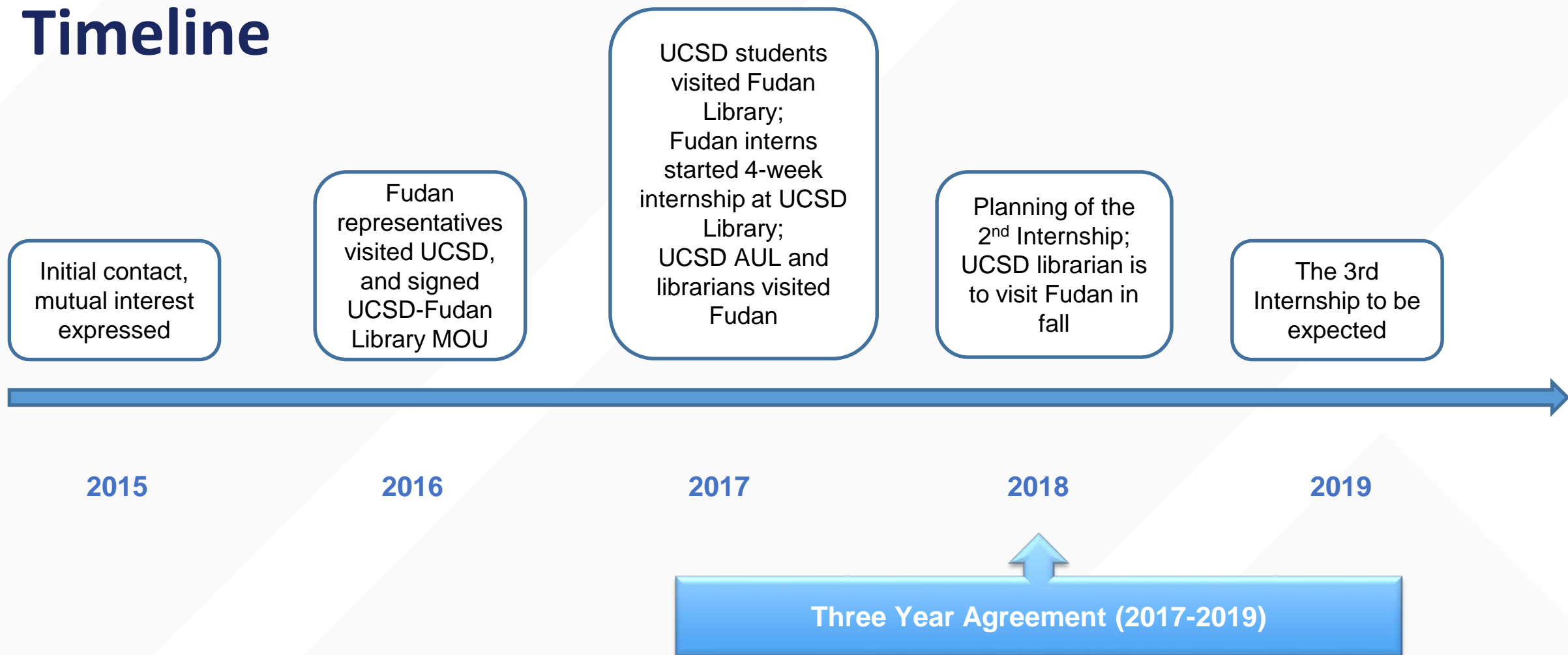

Timeline





Management of the Program (Fudan)

- Make Decision:
 - Discussing if Library provides financial support for student interns.
 - Distant Management
 - Plan and goal of the internship
- Make rules and regulations:

" selection guidelines for students of overseas internship project at Fudan University Documentation and Information Center"



Management of the Program (Fudan)

- Selection Procedure
 - Send announcement and accept students applications
 - English Test (including Oral English)+ GPA(专业成绩) + Overall Performance (平时表现)



Management of the Program (Fudan)

- Help student's Preparing for the travel
 - Procedure in the University
 - Visa
 - Education of safety
- Keep in touch with colleagues of UCSD
- Keep in touch with students
