Thanks for the info.

I have reviewed the databases, it should not be difficult, provided that Prof. Yeh and her research team can provide structured data. There should be copyright concerned if the data are newspaper clippings. Having it typed (not image) should resolve the issue.

Frankly speaking, even Drupal can handle this simple job. However, for a more serious DH project, I think we need to study the potential of the data, but not only setup a simple web search for it.

The metadata is not an issue, as you suggest, we may involve CP team for handling, but in view of the 2 projects you listed, the data structure is very simple after we all gained experience from repository projects that we have been worked on.

A meeting would be needed for the project kick off.

Tony, it is time for us to explore a platform /CMS that can contain this kind of projects.

If not, we can link to wiki or imdb





- A much better tool than Excel / traditional Library full text database
- For instance, Charlie Chaplin in Colonial Hong
 Kong has 974 entries while Buster Keaton recorded
 only 187, showing the wide gap of the exposure
 between the two iconic stars on Hong Kong's early
 screens. And there are plenty of things to find in the
 two databases that will assist in developing
 hypotheses or agendas in need of empirical backing.

For Researchers (research on importers/distributors)





 Before the First World War, most of the films imported to Hong Kong were controlled by Pathé Freres (Abel 1999). It is telling that 2314 entries on Colonial Hong Kong appear under the keyword Pathé. This figure is more than those found for American companies Paramount (1000 entries), Fox (722 entries), and Metro and Goldwyn (797 entries).
