

NUS Chinese Library


- Established in 1953, at University of Malaya
- Absolving collections from the former Nanyang University, Institute of East Asian Philosophies Library and Japanese Resources Department from NUS Central Library
- Over 490,000 volumes of Chinese materials (as at June 08)
- Ranked after Library of Congress and Harvard Yenching Library





 - 2. Provide convenient access to researchers and students







缘起

东南亚(旧称南洋)是中国移民海外历史较久,人数最多的地区。远在宋朝时期,中国的商贾与工匠(包括矿工及技术人员)就开始额洋过海,把中国国内的商业,手工业及矿业实践引申到菲津宾、爪哇、西婆罗洲与泰国等地,成为东南亚最早的一种移民:其后,中国移民以华商、华工、华侨、华裔或再移民等形态移居东南亚,从落叶归粮到落地生粮,逐渐形成海外华人的最大社群。

几百年来,移居东南亚的华人在各个居留国组织社团、创办学校、开办报馆、出版刊物,留下了数以万计的历史文献。这些珍贵的文献,是研究东南亚华人移民史、社会史、经济史、政治活动与宗教传播等各方面的第一手资料,但可惜却因没有获得社会的重视,任由之随时日流进而湮灭,不复留存者为数难以估计。


Benefits (Cont.)
