
- What are we building?

Digitization versus Digital Projects

- Digitization
 - to provide access
 - is a "snapshot" of the item
 - conventional metadata, using current standards of description
 - May have a preservation component
 - Conventional access

- Digital projects
 - Adds a service layer of some type
 - Innovative forms of presentation
 - Digital object reuse and exchange
 - Not only a new DL standard
 - But also a key feature of the emerging digital landscape
 - Web 2.0 features

Conventional access

- Functionality similar to Library catalogs
 - Search data records
 - Browse data records
 - Lists (subjects, names)
 - View digital objects
 - Browse digital objects
 - Turn pages
 - Union catalogs
 - OAI (Open Archives Initiative) harvesting


New ways of interacting with digital objects (Web 2.0) (Virtual Research Environment

- User participation, community-generated content
 - Features of Wiki (ability to edit), Blog (comment)
 - Comments, reviews, commentary (scholarship), publication
 - "tag", annotate, recombine, "mash-up"
 - Leads to creation of new knowledge or understanding
 - Upload new digital content

Popular culture as Web 2.0 focus

- Frontera collection of Mexican and Mexican-American sound recordings
 - 78 & 45rpm phonograph discs
- American orientalism
 - Photographs, books, sheet music, sound recordings





Mass digitization of special collections?

- Just a matter of time (and money!)
- "Careful digitization on a grand scale"
- Parallel to microfilm
- For broad access, not preservation

Digital Library services

- Digitization on demand
 - For instruction
 - For research
- Provide access to detail available in master image
 - Zoom and pan
- Web 2.0 features
- Make metadata harvestable
- Encourage "reuse and exchange"

 - Medieval and Renaissance
- Books
 - Solinus, 1512
- Maps and plans
 - Orsini archive

Proactive digitization

- Caro Minasian collection
 - New Julfa and Isfahan, Iraq
 - Languages
 - Armenian, Persian, Arabic, others
 - Books and manuscripts
 - Religious texts, philosophy, medicine, other secular texts
 - One of the most extensive post-classical Islamic manuscript collections in the United States




Hypercities










Generic access model
