





Chris Patten on the challenges faced by China:

Today, China's 1.3 billion people have made their country into the world's workshop. They have the highest production rates of steel and cement. They make a large number of whatever products you are likely to buy from trainers to tracksuits, from televisions to laptops, from microwaves to children's toys. . . Where not long ago, we asked a little quizzically whether this Chinese "thing" could possibly continue at its present rate, we now depend on it continuing, not least so that the proceeds of all this Chinese growth can bail out our banks and make up for the calamitous consequences of our asset-inflation and asset-invention in the West.

China pays a high price for this roar-away, rip-along growth. It has the highest consumption of coal and fertilizers as well as tobacco. It is the biggest consumer of timber. Seven thousand new cars drive out every day onto China's vastly increased road network and this increase will continue unabated until 2030. Air quality is dreadful; according to the Chinese Academy of Environmental Planning, 380,000 people are likely to die prematurely each year by 2010 from respiratory ailments. Soil is eroding and descriptication spreading. Water quality is had and

The Chinese leadership seem to understand perfectly well the scale of their environmental problems, which are already a heavy drain on the economy and which have the potential to derail it. In 2006 the Party boss in Shanghai, Chen Liangyu, was sacked partly because of his opposition to the Beijing leadership's attempt to rein in economic growth, to make it more equitable and to clean up heavily polluted industries. They know the arrogant folly of Mao's slogan "Man must conquer nature", which overturned the traditional Chinese belief in harmony between nature and mankind.


But however much President Hu or Premier Wen may appreciate the need for sweeping changes to save China's environment, how much can they actually make such reforms stick at the local level? How far beyond Beijing's beltway does the writ of today's emperors run? Moreover, how are Chinese leaders to incorporate environmental concern into the main legitamising project, which is to continue increasing and if possible spreading prosperity? They may fear that environmental problems could create political turbulence; they also surely worry that any slowing down in the helterskelter growth of the economy risks destroying the credibility and rationale for an authoritarian political system, Communist by name but bruisingly Capitalist by method. This is not an academic conundrum to the rest of us. Finding a Chinese solution is a main key to saving the planet.

In addition to the other problems detailed here, in 2007 China had to cope like everyone else with growing food prices. These were in part the result of rising demand for a more varied diet, and in part the result of drought and higher grain prices in Australia. The Chinese leadership could have been forgiven for thinking that the tangled climate change quandaries dwarfed any of the other problems confronting them.



- Mong Kong NewsBot is a full-text news retrieval system that provides various search features for retrieving the news items distributed by major Hong Kong newspaper publishers and news agencies. Developed by stages, the database covers data far back to *January 1, 1995.* (Please click <u>"Coverage"</u> for a detailed description)
- Starting from January 1, 2000, Hong Kong NewsBot subscribes to the news data supplied by WISERS Information Ltd. and hence, the database allows searching 2 different sets of news data, namely,
 - for searching news items published within the most recent 7 days, i.e., searching "Today" and "Last 7 days", users will be directed to the
 newspapers' internet editions through the hyperlinks provided (Robot downloading the internet articles to database from 12:00noon to 12:10pm
 every day). Five internet editions are presently available covering most of the sections except Sports, Entertainment and miscellaneous items.

 - o Ming Pao
 - o Sing Tao Daily

Bowker 2007 Report

- Bowker Reports U.S. Book Production Flat in 2007 Traditional Book Publishing Steady, But "On Demand" Publishing Soars as New Technologies Reduce Barriers to Entry
- New Providence, N.J. May 28, 2008 Bowker, the global leader in bibliographic information management, today released statistics on U.S. book publishing for 2007, compiled from its *Books In Print®* database. Based on preliminary figures from U.S. publishers, Bowker is projecting that U.S. title output in 2007 increased slightly to 276,649 new titles and editions, up from the 274,416 that were published in 2006. While traditional book publishing was basically flat last year, there was a in the reported number of "On Demand" and short-run books to 134,773, pushing the grand total for projected 2007 U.S. book output to 411,422 books. To maintain the continuity of statistics, Bowker is excluding this output from its traditional reporting and has begun tracking the On Demand industry segment separately.

The IDPF's work in standards development occurs within the structure of Working Groups. The following specifications have been approved by the membership and officially published or are in the official IDPF output process:

Current Specifications

".epub" is the file extension of an XML format for reflowable digital books and publications. ".epub" is composed of three open standards, the Open Publication Structure (OPS), Open Packaging Format (OPF) and Open Container Format (OCF), produced by the IDPF, ".epub" allows publishers to produce and send a single digital publication file through distribution and offers consumers interoperability between software/hardware for unencrypted reflowable digital books and other publications. The Open eBook Publication Structure or "OEB", originally produced in 1999, is the precursor to OPS.

For the latest on IDPF specification, sample files, implementations etc., we highly recommend you visit the IDPF Standards Forums. Registration and posting is open to the public.








In addition to text in XML, a reader for OEB publications must be able to render still images in JPEG and PNG formats. 

Books from the Royal Library's online catalogue REX are now available as eBooks. To begin with, this project covers books published between 1500 and 1900.

Order a book



be ordered as eBooks are marked with this EOD-icon in our online catalogue REX. The icon indicates that this book can be ordered as a digital copy.

Click and order

If a user clicks on the EOD-ikon and orders a digital copy of a book, the library digitizes the book and sends it as a file directly to the user by email. The file can be used without limits by the user.

Payment

Payment is only required the first time a book is ordered. The price for a digital copy depends on the number of pages in the book. There is a base fee of DKK 50.- per book as well as DKK 2.- per page. A book of 150 pages will thus cost DKK 350.-, whereas a book of 300 pages will cost DKK 650.-However, only the first user has to pay for the book. Others who order the book as a digital copy will receive it free of charge.

The EBM

Hardware:

The EBM is a fully integrated patented book making machine which can automatically print, bind and trim on demand at point of sale perfect bound library quality paperback books with 4-color cover indistinguishable from their factory made versions.

Espresso 1.5 is modular in 2 parts and measures about 9 feet long, 5 feet high and about five feet deep with printers.

The EBM will print bind and trim a 300 page book in about 7 minutes with a one printer model and in about 3 minutes with a two printer model. As many as six printers can be integrated into the EBM. Production cost is a penny a page and minimal human intervention is required for operation. The trim size of a book is infinitely variable between $8.5'' \times 11''$ and $4.5'' \times 4.5''$ and the EBM version 1.5 can bind up to 550 pages.

Routine intervention is needed for such tasks as refilling paper trays and emptying the trim receptacle tray.

Occasionally, a paper jam will occur but the frequency is on par with any high quality laser imaging machine, perhaps once or twice a day under heavy use. Once cleared, books will continue to print from the page where they left off.

Consumables used by the EBM are paper, cover stock and toner suitable for laser printers, glue and charcoal filters. The glue comes in pellet form; a single box will cost less than \$100 and can be used for roughly 10,000 books. Perhaps one charcoal filter is required per month at a cost of less than
